









**Times Picayune - August 30, 1874**

This afternoon the celebrated band, under the direction of Charley Jaeger, will give a free concert at this popular resort, including the most popular airs of the day. In the evening the gardens will be beautifully illuminated, and an exhibition of the works, followed by a ball, will be given.

This charming coral resort is situated at the Bayou Bridge, and is reached by two lines of street cars, which leave Canal Street every few minutes. In the afternoon a free concert of the choicest music is given, and in the evening dancing on the platform makes the hours glide swiftly by.
